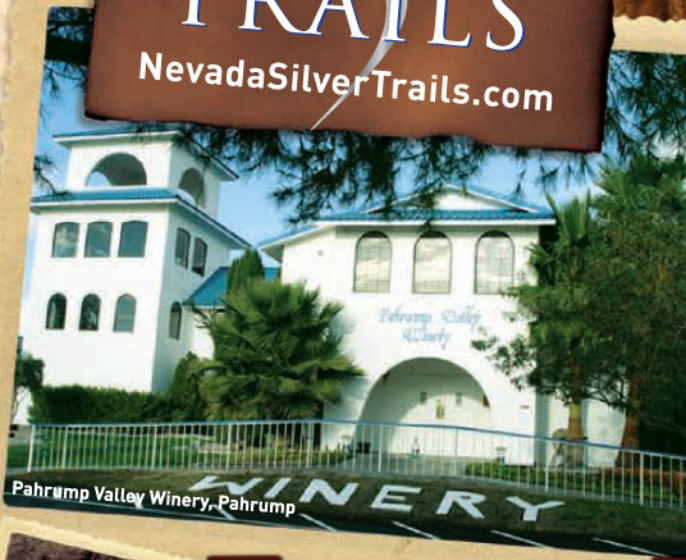
PAHRUMP | BEATTY

From an award winning winery, to a quaint little old west town, to one of the hottest places on earth, you'll find Pahrump, NV and Beatty, NV to be the perfect places to enjoy it all. With both towns nestled just minutes from Death Valley, they are the perfect home base to enjoy modern day luxuries while exploring Death Valley National Park.

DAY 1: If you're an avid golfer, arrive in Pahrump early enough to play a few holes at the award winning **Mountain Falls Golf Course**. If speed is your thing, then stop by **Spring Mountain Motor Sports** and try your luck around the track, or if you prefer off-road, rent some ATV's and head up into the **Spring Mountains** where there are plenty of ATV trails and site seeing. In the evening, make sure to sample one of the local **Pahrump Wineries** and visit one of the many **outstanding restaurants** for a satisfying dinner. After that, grab some rest because day 2 will take you to the extremes, just opposite of the luxuries of day 1.

DAY 2: Wake up bright and early and head 55 miles Northwest on Hwy 190 to **Death Valley National Park**. Plan on spending the entire day here, as there's plenty to see and do. You can start your day at **Furnace Creek**, where you'll find the visitors center, souvenir shops, snacks and supplies for your adventure. Be sure to take some time to hike and explore at least one of the many scenic canyons in the area, as well as stop by **Badwater Basin** (the lowest point in North America at 292 ft. below sea level). You can then head north toward the the **Ubehebe Crater** (a volcanic formation that's 777 feet deep). If time allows and you are driving an off-road vehicle, **The Racetrack** is definitely a sight to see with a 73 ft. high boulder formation in the center known as the Grandstand, as well as the **mysterious phenomenon of "moving rocks"**. Whatever you choose to see, be sure to stop by **Scotty's Castle**, where the offer guided tours of this ornate structure in the middle of one of the most disolate and harsh surroundings. After a full day in the heat of Death Valley, you'll want to make your way to Beatty, Nevada where you can cool off a bit and get a comfortable room.

DAY 3: Before heading out, roam around this quaint little old west town and you'll find amazing shops, great food and you may just run into a few of the towns **roaming old west gunfighters** putting on a show. To learn a little history about the town, stop by the **Beatty Museum** to get an inside look at this areas rich history. You also might want to make the short drive out to **Rhyolite**, an old mining ghosttown with the one of a kind **Goldwell Open Air Museum** in the middle of the desert that is sure to surprise anyone.
